95 C. H. Berres Riesling Auslese Gold Cap Mosel-Saar-Ruwer Erdener Treppchen 2005

\$60/375ml Tastes like there's a touch of botrytis. Lemon candy, spice and marzipan mingle with the sweetness and the lively structure. Almost sweet-tart, like an eiswein, then ends with a mouthwatering tanginess. Very intense. Best from 2009 through 2028. 23 cases made.—B.S.

95 C. H. Berres Riesling Beerenauslese Gold Cap Mosel-Saar-Ruwer Erdener Treppchen 2005

\$95/375ml Intense, exuding botrytis character that shows in its dried apricot, mango and passion fruit flavors, with spice and honey accents. Appears soft, yet there is ample acidity to carry this. Drink now through 2035. 21 cases made.—B.S.

97 C. H. Berres Riesling Trockenbeerenauslese Gold Cap Mosel-Saar-Ruwer Ürziger Würzgarten 2005

\$145/375ml Shows an intense lemon candy flavor, with hints of caramel, spice and a sweetness offset by tangy acidity. Elegant, fresh and beautifully balanced, with a long finish. Drink now through 2040. 10 cases made.—B.S.
